

## **Permanent Makeup Pre-procedure general information.**

- An appointment for one new procedure take 1h30min.
- Topical anaesthetics are applied before and during a procedure. This helps a lot for your comfort. For eyeliner it is also good to know that you keep your eyes closed during the appointment so that also makes it easier.
- For eyeliner; please ensure that you do not have any eyelash extensions on on the day of your appointment.
- If you wear contact lenses, you may want to rather wear your glasses on that day. If you do not have glasses, it is not a problem as we do have contact lens solution here.
- Touch-up appointments: We generally do not book a touch up appointment, as most clients have a successful result after only one appointment. However, it may be that a follow up treatment is needed on rare occasions. This is something you have to be aware of beforehand, as a follow up appointment is NOT included in the initial price. We do not want to charge our clients for an appointment they most likely will not need so the price for this is separate. In the case where a touch up is needed, the touch up must be done within 3 months. The cost of a touch up within three months is R500 and is only applicable where the first procedure was done by Nikki van Gend. The cost of the touch up is R500 regardless of how big or small the area is that needs to be addressed again.
- There is not a “one size fits all” design for all our clients. Each person is treated as a special unique case and the choice of design for your permanent makeup is discussed in detail on the day of the appointment.
- Permanent makeup is a form of cosmetic tattooing and therefore is a long term solution. There is no specific amount of years that it lasts; it is indefinite. Various factors influence the longevity of the result for example: How dark the colour was we chose, how well you looked after it, the condition of your skin, and a few other various points. When your permanent cosmetic design starts to fade, you may contact the salon for an appointment to have it done again (a long term touch up). The cost if this is R800 – for clients who had it done at Image Division before with Nikki van Gend. In the case where permanent makeup has been left to fade away completely, it will be treated as a new procedure.
- After the appointment you can expect the skin to be sensitive for a few days. Cream will be supplied for you to apply along with printed aftercare instructions.
- More than one procedure can be done in one appointment, and we prefer this. If you would like to do eyeliner and eyebrows together on one day you are welcome to. Just make sure you booked accordingly so that enough time was booked out.
- Lip colour: If you have had a cold sore / fever blister in the past; please get anti-viral medication from your doctor beforehand. This you can start to take two days before the appointment. It is of utmost importance for full lip colour appointments.

- You may wear your normal day makeup on the day of the appointment it is not necessary to remove your makeup beforehand.
